- 1.- The customer shall deliver all mares and foals to Manvers Meadows in a healthy and sound condition and free from disease accompanied with a history of breeding, foaling dates, vaccination, de-worming, trimming and all other records reasonably demanded by Manvers Meadows.
- 2.- Every mare must have a NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST for equine infectious anemia dated no earlier than two years prior to the date of her arrival at the farm. A certificate to this effect must accompany the mare upon her arrival at the farm. The mare must be vaccinated against Rhinopneumontis, Tetanus, Rabies, and West Nile prior to arrival. Manvers Meadows reserves the right to vaccinate mares that arrive without vaccination documentation.
- 3.- Manvers Meadows is authorized, without liability and in its sole discretion, to engage veterinary service, trim feet, de-worm, vaccinate, administer feed supplements, conduct veterinary examinations or do any other work on said mare or foal deemed by Manvers Meadows as contributory to their general or reproductive health or appearance, with charges for such services to be billed monthly. The mare owner agrees to pay all such charges, plus board charges, within thirty days of being billed.
- 4.- All accounts for boarding and for all other expenditures made on behalf of the Customer's mare and/or her foals are required to be settled in full before they are removed from the Manvers Meadows premises. A service charge of 1.5 % monthly shall be charged on all overdue accounts. All unpaid boarding charges and other expenditures shall be a lien on the Customers mares and foals.
- 5.- Positively no blind, chronically lame, vicious or unmanageable mares or foals shall be accepted by Manvers Meadows.
- 6.- The customer shall give Manvers Meadows 24 hours notice prior to the arrival or departure of all horses, mares and or foals.
- 7.- Manvers Meadows, its agents, employees, farriers and veterinarians (and the owners of all other horses boarding at Manvers Meadows) shall not be liable for any injury, death, accident or disability suffered by any horse, mare, foal or yearling owned by the Customer from any cause whatsoever, including without limitations from fire, lightning and any accidental incidents, while in the care and control of Manvers Meadows or while on the premises of Manvers Meadows. THE CUSTOMER IN SIGNING THIS BOARDING CONTRACT SPECIFICALLY ASSENTS TO THE FOREGOING CONDITION OF THIS CONTRACT AND HEREBY EXPRESSLY WAIVES ALL CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF OR RESULTING FROM ANY SUCH INJURY, DEATH, ACCIDENT OR DISABILITY TO THE HORSE, MARE, FOAL AND OR YEARLING.
